Roadsafe Rear Extended Sway Bar Links

Why upgrade your Sway Bar Links from standard to Roadsafe Extended Thread Patrol style?

If your sway bar is out of alignment due to lifting your vehicle, handling may be affected.

The Roadsafe Extended Thread Patrol links allow you to effectively trim the sway bar link to your desired length to provide adequate tail shaft clearance and sway bar re-alignment.

The benefit of the design is the ability to make the adjustment to get the perfect setting for your Patrol.



How are the Roadsafe Extended Sway Bar Links different to standard?

Manufactured from 16mm rod, Roadsafe Extended Patrol links offer both increased strength and increased stud articulation, providing for less stress on the sway bar links during wheel articulation.

Additionally, the Roadsafe Extended Patrol links are longer to suit for the larger lifts (up to 8") and have a long thread to allow for adjustment.



What fits where?

The sway bar link set up between GQ and GU are different. The GU LH Rear is a different link to the GQ. With regard to the Roadsafe Extended Patrol links, they are fitted as per following:

GQ Patrol

STB8828ET x 4 (both sides Front & Rear)

GU Patrol

STB8828ET x 3 (Fronts and RH Rear)

STB8833ET x 1 (LH Rear)



What lifts do the Extended Thread links suit?

The Roadsafe Extended Patrol links suit for 2 to 8" lifts.

If you have less than 2" of suspension lift you can use the standard sway bar links.
