## **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

12mm Socket

## HARDWARE SUPPLIED:

- 1 x Dual Battery Tray
  - 1 x Dual Battery Tray Strap
- 3 x Battery Tie Down
  3 x M8 Washer
- 3 x M8x1.25 Flange Nut

INSTRUCT

1. Unclip and remove battery cover exposing vehicle cranking battery.


2. Unclip and remove top skuttle plate section above battery for easy access.

3. Remove 2 x M12 bolts clamping the battery in place. Loosen terminals and remove battery.

 Remove M12 x 9 bolts to release factory battery tray, retain factory hardware. Note: There are two layers that form the OE battery tray. Remove both. See figure 1.

5. Insert Roadsafe Auxiliary Battery Tray and bolt into position using 7 of the factory M12 bolts. See figure 2.

6. Place both batteries side by side. Depending on application will determine which direction terminals will face.

**NOTE** Suggested fitment of dual battery set up to be completed by a qualified 12V automotive technician. Roadsafe Dual Battery Tray is designed to accommodate a maximum of 2 x N70 batteries.

 Before positioning and securing battery strap over batteries, ensure the appropriate wiring is complete as the rear most terminals will be difficult to access once secured.
 It is recommended this be completed by a qualified 12v automotive technician.

 Position the top battery strap over the batteries and secure using supplied battery tie downs, washers, and flange nuts. See figure 3.

9. Now with both batteries in position, proceed to wire batteries into the desired configuration.

**10.** Once both batteries have been fully installed back into the system, return the removed plastic skuttle plate to its original position.

 Depending on dual battery configuration, re-attach the top plastic battery cover. See figure 4.
